

TechNotes by Nick Buchholz

I got a few pieces of info the other day when looking for track standards If you're having derail problems check these dimensions. The following are used by the Gauge 1 Model Railroad Association (G1MRA).

 Track Gauge Ideal Minimum Minimum 1.750 (44.45mm)

 (by extension)
 Maximum 1.793 (45.55mm)

Wheel specs - Back to back Distance 1.574 (40.0mm) No tolerance given on this but plus or minus 0.0197 (.5mm) is reasonable to expect.

Flange Thickness .0591 (1.5mm)

Note most of our wheel flanges are thicker

Flange Height .076 (2mm)

Includes the tread taper, again most of our flanges are much taller.

Tread width .177 (4.5mm) Wheel Thickness .236 (6.0mm)

Rail Height is spec'd at 5.5mm or just 0.216 ". We use 8.4mm or 0.332". And these aren't even the fine scale specs which use 0.197" rail! So the next time you have track problems thank your lucky stars you have it so easy
