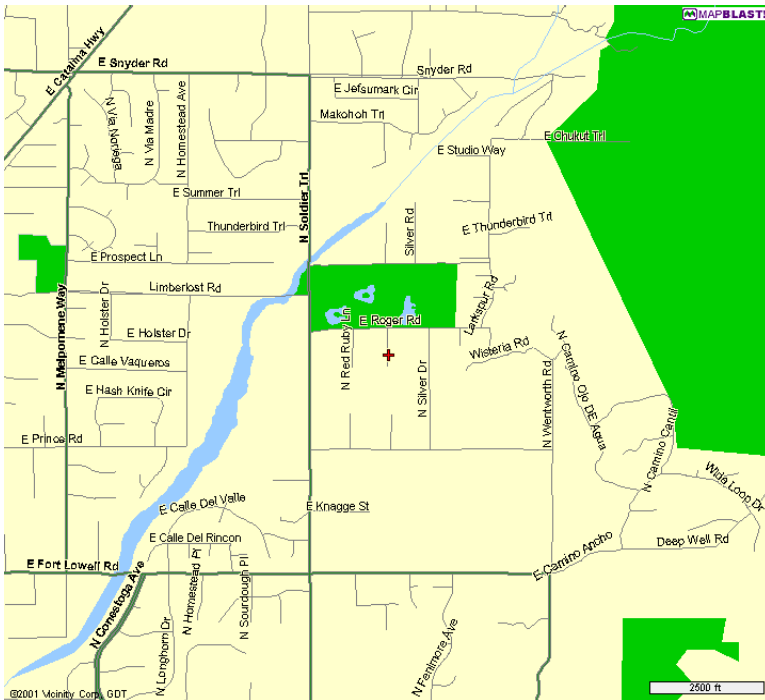
## TGRS Meeting Oct 13<sup>th</sup> at the Karrels'.

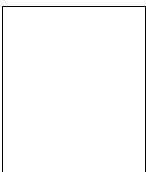
