# Minutes of the Board Meeting from October 15, 2013

Meeting was called to order by President Gary Martin at the home of the Martins. Hosts were thanked for opening up their home.

Minutes from the September board meeting were approved.

Ruth Taylor reported that as of 10/15/13 checking account balance is \$8,743, saving account is \$17,225 for a total of \$25,967. Revenues from 9/13/13 are \$693, expenses are \$675 leaving a gain of \$18. Year to date revenues are \$1257 with expenses of \$2499 leaving a net loss of \$1242. Total dues received to date for 2013/2014 are \$2102.

#### Vice President Willis Fagg reported

McCormik/Stillman could use more people on the bus. The bus leaves at 8:00 AM from Foothills Mall on OCTOBER  $10^{TH}$ .

ABTO Tour on Nov 2<sup>nd</sup> has 16 people signed up so far. Instructions will be e-mailed to everyone. There are 6 layouts and lunch. It was suggested we meet at Oracle and McGee to caravan up to Phoenix.

December 20<sup>th</sup> is the second Christmas event for the children at the UMC Diamond Children's Center. Setup will at 10:00AM. Trains will run from noon to 1:30 or 2:00PM.

December 26-30 is the set up, running and tear down at the VA Hospital. Sign ups are needed.
