New Business:

- The annual Christmas party will be on Saturday, December 10th at the Golden Corral on Thornydale. A \$20 gift exchange will occur for those wanting to participate.
- A presentation of the new TBG layout (about 175', designed by Charlie Weesner) was approved by the general membership (after much discussion). We will begin work ASAP so we can be done by November before the big TBG event starts. TBG is planning on a multi-month event for the holidays and we don't want to be in the way. They have promised to reimburse us for any expenses during the setup. Claudia and Margaret suggested putting up a sign explaining garden railroading along with some of our club members' layouts and have worked on the wording.
- The Gadsen-Pacific swap meet will be Sunday, November 13th. We will have 2 tables and have been asked to bring the mini-layout. Dennis and John will empty the storage unit to see what we might be able to sell.
- Ocotillo Learning Center has contacted us to bring our mini-layout on December 15th (Thursday), as we did a couple of years ago. Claudia will get pencils (with our name) and John will bring candy to hand out to the children as they come through. This year we will have all RC engines, so cords won't be an issue, and we'll create a holiday theme.
- Dennis would like suggestions for a 2-5 year plan for the club to recruit new members, especially younger members. He'd like everyone to be thinking of ways to get our club promoted.
- Gina Blackwell will be holding a sale for club members on October 14-15.
