

15 club members signed the attendance sheet. Minutes were approved as-published from September meeting.

John Fennema (for Margaret Nelson) reviewed the treasurer's report with 39 paid families, 8 will get reminder email for a Nov 15 deadline to bring their dues up-to-date. 6 honorary members.

Jerry has made contact with Harley's Toy Shop in Tucson Mall. Scheduled a meeting to explore holiday "events" we might support.

Thomas Preisner donated a battery-power 2-6-2 tank engine by NEWQIDA for the mini layout so we can run the small layout without AC power. He has bought these from www.hammondtoy.com in Salt Lake City.

TBG layout construction is on-schedule. We start laying track on Monday, with planned 8:30-10:30 workdays Monday and Thursday this week and next.

An obituary for Gary Martin has been posted on the FaceBook page of Havasu Pioneers. When Peggy is ready, we expect we will be "doing something in memory of Gary," and the Botanical Gardens has agreed to dedicate the new layout to his memory.

Thomas Preisner reports that following the publication of John Charmichael's article on the funicular model he's built, the same German magazine has requested an article on his layout. He also invites anyone to give him a call if they're interested in rail-fanning around Casa Grande.
