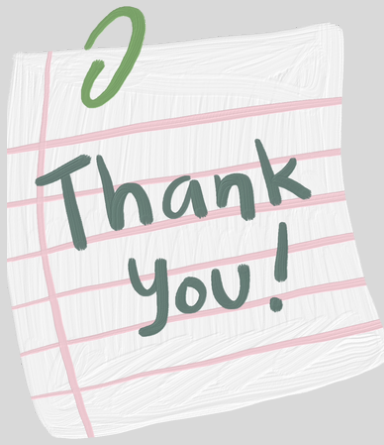
John Fennema passed out awards (see web site for details).
