

#### ABTO Membership Meeting Minutes, June 21, 2025 held at VVL Pro Shop

1/ Welcome-Darrell welcomed everyone and began meeting at 9:40am

**2/ Richard Nedrow's Collection-**Darrell mentioned that the family went with the EBay Auction and Vince had seen some of the items on that website. The son had told Darrell that ABTO gets first choice if anything is left over. ABTO was willing to write a check first thing and bring up to members to purchase at the ABTO auction. Darrell read off some of the prices that he had presented to the son. Steve Lewis mentioned that the family will be lucky if they get 15 cents on a dollar.

#### 3/ Presentations: Darrell Woolfolk, Vince Simpson & Don Sorenson

<u>Coupler Height-</u>Darrell had mentioned that Mark McKellip had always asked about couplers. Darrell spoke about coupler heights and mentioned that there are different brands of couplers. Steve L. mentioned he thought Bachman was selling Aristocraft couplers. Darrell had suggested their should be a conversion car in everyone's collection.

<u>Lubrication</u>-Don spoke about syringes being handy to use. He has a glass syringe filled with WD40 that is good for couplers. A long needle syringe is good for oil. 3 in 1 oil good for wheels. Darrell had brought the truck off of the tender of a car that he had purchased and would like to display the whole set at Railfair and will ask if that would be possible. The collection was built 45 years ago.

<u>Track Cleaning</u>-Vince spoke about track cleaning and works best by cleaning by hand. Can use track power by using a bright block for Aristocraft 4 wheel caboose. Bright Block-\$45.00 and Caboose for \$75.00 plus shipping per item. Can use a sanding block-Scotch Brite. Vince handed out samples of Masonite pieces to try out cleaning track and let him know your thoughts about using the Masonite at the July meeting.

<u>Weighting Cars-</u>Can use weights or adjust the screw can work. Darrell mentioned that he has 3" wide steel plates available for members, just contact him. Steve Lewis mentioned that Hobby Lobby has Pinewood Derby Weights found in the toy department.

Then a question and answer session followed.

Thank you to Darrell, Vince and Don for their presentations.

<u>4/ July Meeting-VVL Pro Shop-Landscaping-</u>Darrell mentioned previously plants and landscaping was scheduled. Trevor Fields will ask his mother, Carolyn, if she would be interested in doing a presentation on landscaping, etc.. Richard Webster uses artificial water.

<u>5/ August Meeting-VVL Pro Shop-Junk Collecting-</u>by\_using various things out of misc. items. Ceramic tile can be used. Take junk and how you can use on your layout. Darrell mentioned that Joanne Gardner was good at knowing what to do with things she was going to purchase.


